

Pre-Junior Degree Audit Process

As of February, 2019

Prior to registration for their fifth semester (during the second semester of sophomore year), students will be notified that they must complete the degree audit process before they can register for classes.

Tentative plans for each of these student's remaining four years will be completed by the Director of Academic Progress and Evaluation in the format attached. These plans will be sent to advisors prior to Advising Week (begins March 4, 2019).

Advisors will review the tentative plans for accuracy. In particular, advisors should check program-specific requirements, classes that are offered on rotation, special offerings, and any possible substitutions that may be necessary. These should be noted in the space indicated on the degree audit form. During Advising Week, advisors will go over the degree audit plan with each of their sophomore advisees. They should carefully review courses needed and when each should be taken so that the student can complete degree requirements in a timely manner.

Students will be asked to sign their plans as an indication that they are aware that they must assume responsibility for meeting all graduation requirements. ARC Staff and Advisor signatures will also be required. Students will be directed to turn in their signed forms to the ARC, Room 109, by the stated deadline. The preferred date is the last day of Advising Week prior to Registration.

The ARC will retain the printed plans in each student's existing file so that they will be subject to normal retention and disposal timelines and procedures.
