## Liberal Arts Foundations Courses Required for Bachelor's Degree

Foundations courses introduce students to the full range of academic disciplines traditionally associated with college-level education. Completing these courses provide the foundation upon which the Ferrum College curriculum is built. All bachelor's degree seeking students must complete courses that fulfill the 37 hours of liberal arts requirements. These courses may be taken at either a community college or at Ferrum in order to complete a bachelor's degree. Students transferring foundational courses must earn a grade of "C" or higher in each class. Those eligible for Guaranteed Admission, having already earned an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, or Associate of Arts \& Sciences degree, have met the liberal arts requirements with the exception of a Bible based course.
